**VILLAGE OF DRESSER BOARD RESOLUTION REGARDING THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
ENFORCEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ORDINANCES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE
F&A DAIRY LAGOON SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, F&A Dairy operates a lagoon system within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of Dresser; and

WHEREAS, said lagoon system is regulated and licensed by the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the State of Wisconsin environmental ordinances and Department of Natural Resources enforcement responsibilities concerning the operation of a lagoon system,

And, in full agreement with the State's written position that "the department is obligated to uphold our responsibilities to enforce State law protecting public health and the environment"; and

WHEREAS, the State requires that "the owner/operator must notify the department in writing when the concentration of a substance in the groundwater exceeds the Enforcement Standard"; and


WHEREAS, over several years F&A Dairy has operated in non-compliance resulting in their lagoon system containing excessive levels of bacteria (having gone "septic"); and

WHEREAS, the impact this has had on the citizens and businesses of Dresser and surrounding areas (noxious odors that substantially diminish our quality of life and ability to normally conduct rightful business and personal activities);


WE, VILLAGE OF DRESSER BOARD OF TRUSTEES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE to require and support the State of Wisconsin, Department of Natural Resources, in its role and responsibilities to enforce State law protecting public health and environment, take action concerning the lagoon system including but not limited to requiring a written Plan be submitted to the DNR and provided to the Village, requiring the lagoon be dumped into the sewer system, and or revocation of the license.

WE ALSO HEREBY RESOLVE that a copy of this Resolution be provided to State Senator Shelia Harsdorf, Assemblyman Adam Jarchow, and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
