NR 208 – Compliance Maintenance Resolution

WHEREAS, it is a requirement under a Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) permit issued by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to file a Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR) for its wastewater collection system under Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 208;


WHEREAS, it is necessary to acknowledge that the governing body has reviewed the Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR);

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide recommendations or an action response plan for all individual CMAR section grades (of "C" or less) and/or an overall grade point average (< 3.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village of Dresser Resolves that:

1. The Village Board of Trustees reviewed the 2020 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report at the June 7, 2021 scheduled Village Board Meeting.
2. The Financial Management Section of the 2020 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report received a letter grade of "A" and/or overall grade point average of 4.00.
3. The Village Board adopted Resolution #02-2019 raising the Sewer Rates through a 3-step process. The first rate increase went into effect October 21, 2019. A second increase went into effect October 21, 2020. The third and final increase is planned for October 21, 2021.
4. The Collection Systems Section of the 2020 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report received a letter grade of "A" and/or overall grade point average of 4.00.
5. The Village Board continues to work on Inflow and Infiltration issues in the Sewer Utility. Future Planning includes possible sewer pipe lining by Soo Line and West Avenue. The reduction of I&I into our system will lower the amount of flow to the Village of Osceola Sewer Plant which will hopefully reduce the Sewer Utilities yearly expenses. Additional projects listed as part of Future Planning involve rebuilding or replacing sewer lift station pumps at our Main Lift Station on State Street, repair to Force Main valves from Dresser to Osceola, and replacement of sewer main on First Street from West Avenue to East Avenue.
