RESOLUTION #05-2015

A RESOLUTION TO DISCONTINUE A PORTION OF WEST MAIN STREET

THE VILLAGE BOARD of the Village of Dresser, Polk County, Wisconsin, having conducted a duly noticed public hearing on the matter as required by law commencing at 6:30 p.m., and thereafter having met in duly noticed regular session at 6:30 p.m., on July 13, 2015, upon motion duly made and seconded, does hereby adopt the following:

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Dresser finds that the portion of Main Street west of State Highway 35 will never be extended; and,

WHEREAS, this portion of road within the corporate limits of Dresser is currently classified as a minor street 1,000 feet or more in length with a road Right Of Way designated at 60 feet; and,

WHEREAS, Main Street west of State Highway 35 is actually a minor street less than 1,000 feet in length which allows a Right Of Way of 50 feet; and,

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by all of the abutting property owners requesting a reclassification of Main Street west of State Highway 35 to a minor street less than 1,000 feet with a road Right Of Way to be 50 feet; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds the petition in order as required by Wisconsin State Statutes Section 66.1003(2012-13)

WHEREAS, the Village Board pursuant to resolution adopted on June 1, 2015 has caused a class three notice to be posted under Ch. 985, Wisconsin Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board has caused notice to be posted upon owners of more than one-third of the frontage of the lots and lands abutting on that portion of the remainder of the public way which lies within 2,650 feet of the ends of the portion to be discontinued at least 30 days prior to the public hearing in accordance with Sec. 66.1003, Wisconsin Statutes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that:

1. The Village Board of the Village of Dresser declares that a portion of Main Street west of State Highway 35 be discontinued and reclassified as a minor street less than 1,000 feet in length with a road right of way of 50 feet.
2. The Village Clerk Treasurer is directed pursuant to Wis. Stats. 840.11(2) (2011 -12) to prepare a certified copy of this Resolution, to include a legal description of the affected property, to accompany such certified resolution and description with

a map showing the location thereof, and to record such document and attachment(s) in the office of the Polk County register of deeds.

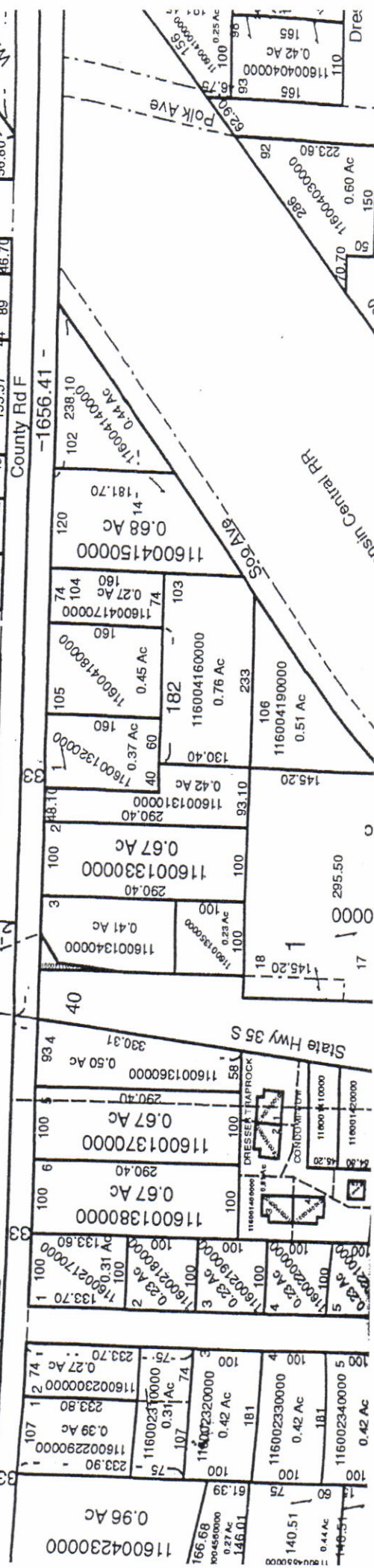
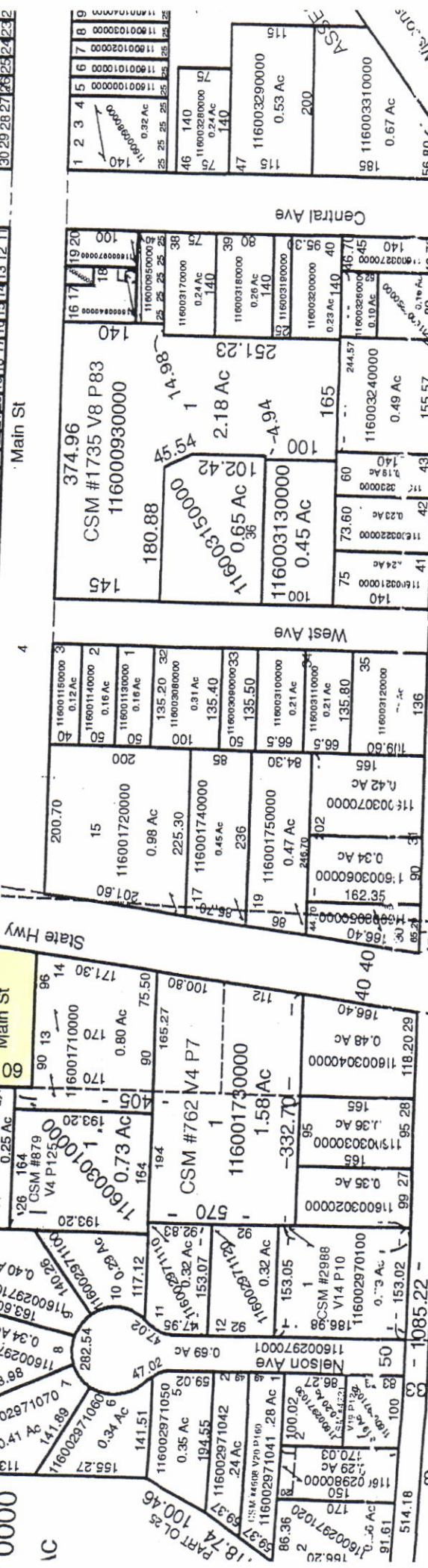
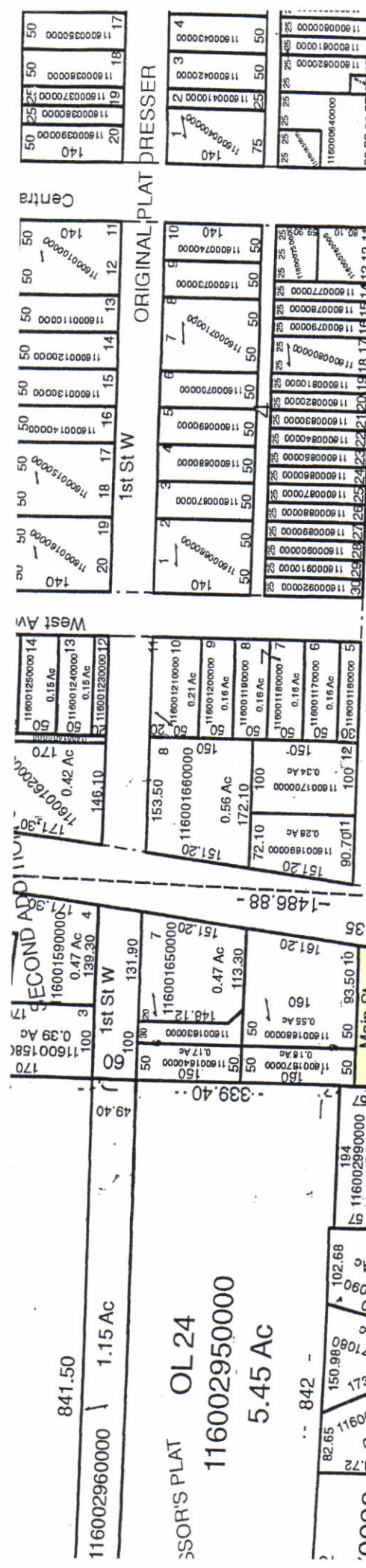
