WisDOT schedules WIS 35 Rehabilitation Public Involvement Meeting

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), Northwest Region is conducting a Public Involvement Meeting regarding the proposed WIS 35 rehabilitation and safety project. The proposed project is in the village of Dresser, Polk County, starting south of the County F intersection and continuing north approximately 1/2-mile.

The meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 22, 2019 from 5:30 - 7 p.m. at the **Dresser Community Hall, 115 West Main Street, Dresser WI, 54009**. The meeting will follow an open house format with a brief presentation beginning at 5:45 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about the project and obtain input on the proposed design. Maps of preliminary roadway improvements will be on display, and WisDOT staff will be on hand to answer questions, and take written and verbal comments.

The proposed improvements involve resurfacing the WIS 35 pavement from approximately 600 feet south of the County F intersection to the intersection of West Avenue. The asphalt pavement will be milled off, and new asphaltic pavement placed. The roadway will be restriped to accommodate a two-way center turn lane. The roadway will not be widened, the width is adequate to accommodate the proposed 3-lanes.

Construction is currently programmed to occur during the summer of 2020.

All interested residents, property and business owners are encouraged to attend the meeting. Citizens who are hearing-impaired and require an interpreter may request one by contacting Diana Maas at least three working days prior to the meeting via the Wisconsin Telecommunications Relay system (dialing 711).
