

VILLAGE OF DRESSER APPLICATION FOR SEWER CONNECTION

Applicants for Village sewer utility service shall adhere to the following regulations and charges when applying for such utility connection:

There shall be two (2) classes of connections

1. Residential and Commercial
2. Industrial

The application shall include a statement giving the exact location of the premises, the purpose for which the connection is to be used, the time when the work is to be done and such other information that may be required by the Village Board; together with an agreement by the owner and the owner's licensed master plumber declaring their agreement to be bound by and subject to the lawful rules and regulations of the Village Board; and the payment of any necessary connection charge.

- A. Each building sewer to be connected to an intercepting sewer shall be inspected by the authorized sewerage system operator employed by the Village or his representative at the time of connection. 48-hour notice required.
- B. After hook-up any pre-existing septic system shall be abandoned in accordance with Section H62 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
- C. The Village will tap the sewer main, purchase and install necessary CV sewer Saddle or its equivalent. The applicant agrees to pay all cost of the installation.
- D. Applicant also agrees to pay all costs of laying sewer connection from the sewer main in the street to the property line, including digging, materials, labor, backfill and cost of any necessary fill dirt and black-topping needed for resurfacing the street where the digging occurred.
- E. New Service Hook-Up Charge of \$4,000.00(Resolution #05-2014) in accordance with code 13.24 New Service HookUp charge.
