

VILLAGE OF DRESSER APPLICATION FOR WATER UTILITY SERVICE CONNECTION

The Village of Dresser Municipal Water Utility is regulated by the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin. The most recent Rate File from the Commission (the tariff) is Amendment 17 effective December 21, 2015.

All persons receiving or those who may request water service in the future, shall be considered as having agreed to be bound by the rules and regulations as filed with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin.

The utility charges customers for the actual cost of installing a water service lateral from the main through curb stop and box if those costs are not contributed as part of a subdivision development or otherwise recovered under Wis. Stat. Chapter 66.

The curb stop box is the property of the water utility and will be maintained and kept in repair and, when worn out, replaced at the expense of the water utility in the future.

The water utility may withhold approval of any application where full information of the purpose of such supply is not clearly indicated and set forth by the applicant property owner.
